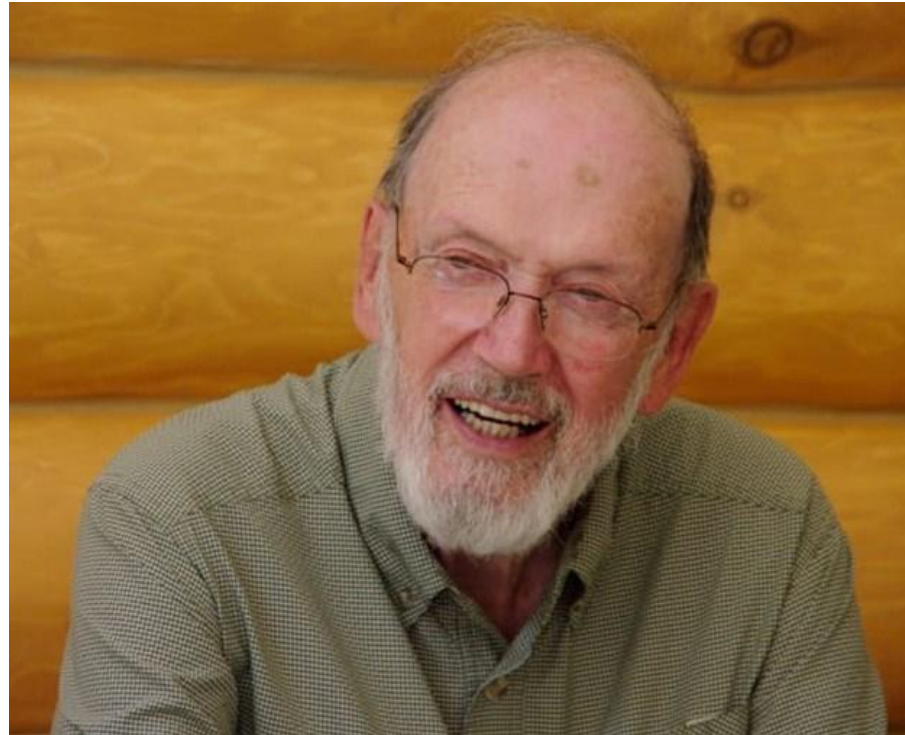
Rev. Paul Packman

Jim was ordained in 1966. He served at Edson-Trail, Clairmont, Queen Street, Northern Lights Presbytery, and Lindsay Presbytery.

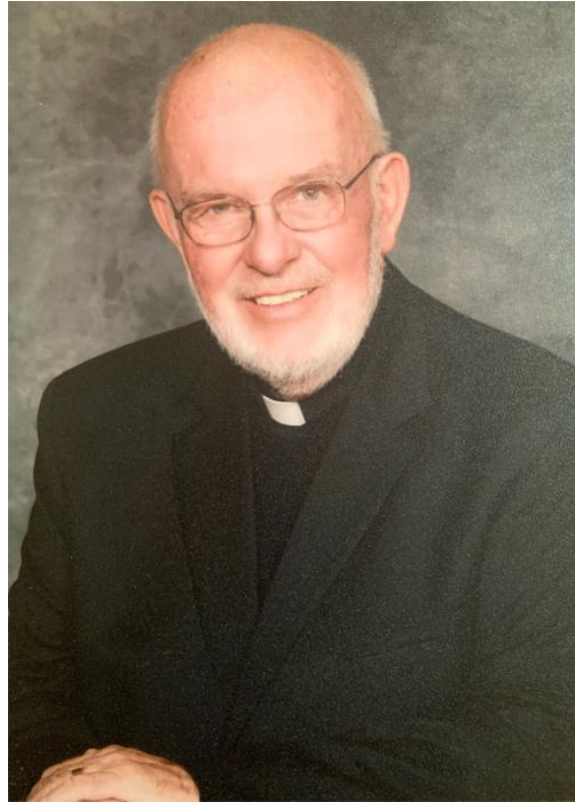
Rev. George F Saunders

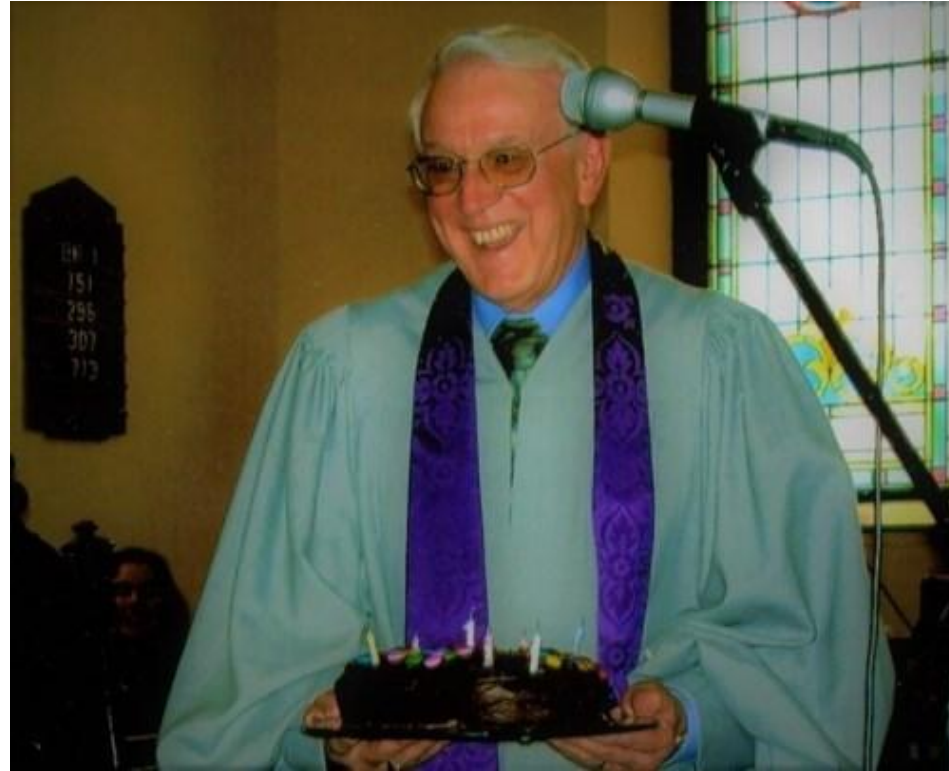
Rev. Linda Saffrey

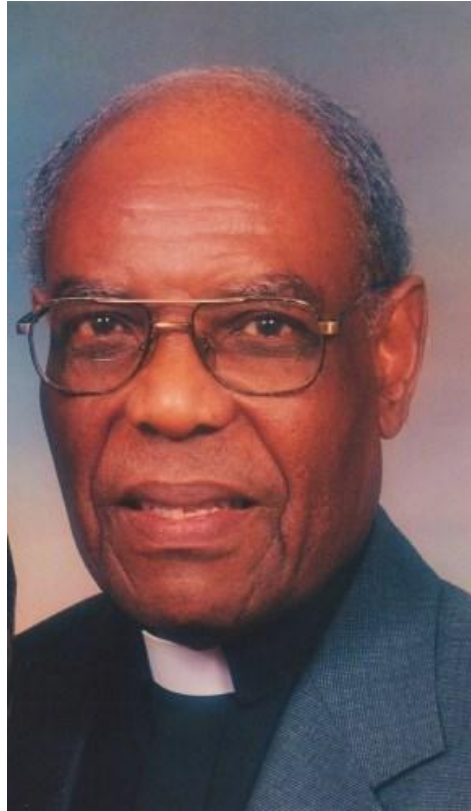
Rev. Molly Byrne Thomson

Conference.

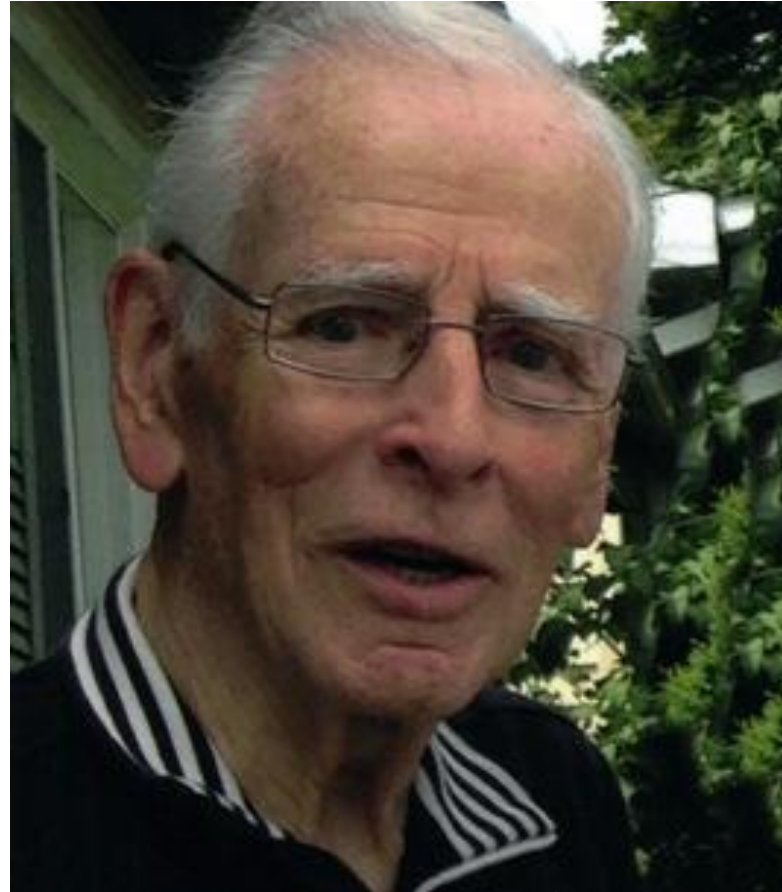
Rev. Rawlier Quammie

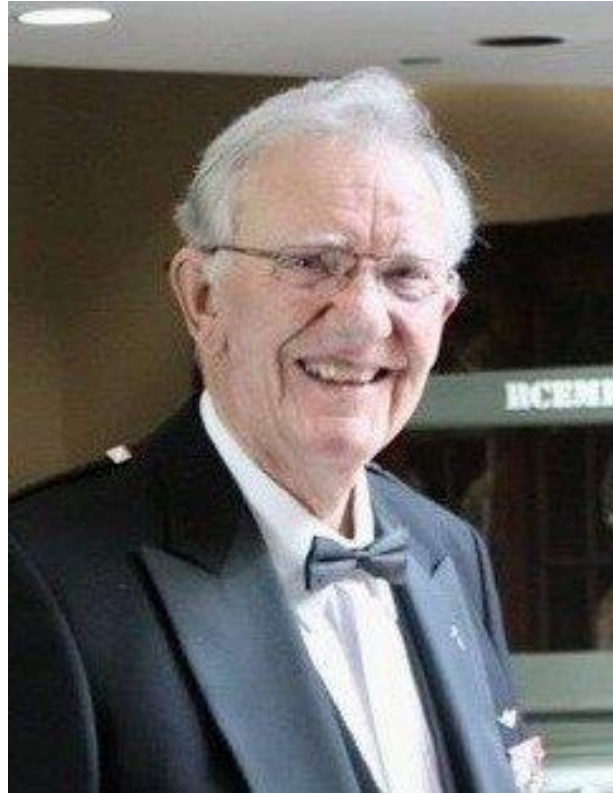
The Rev. David Timpson
